

Certificate in Medical Billing and Coding



A certificate is the lowest level of all degree types, and is most commonly achieved as a means of career preparation. Certificates are often granted for very concentrated areas of study.

A certificate program in medical billing and coding familiarizes students with insurance forms and the CPT and ICD-09 coding systems most commonly used to process insurance forms and claims. Students also understand the legal aspects of maintaining and sharing a patient's personal medical information. Those interested in enrolling the program can find them at many community colleges and vocational schools. These programs typically last from three months to one year.
